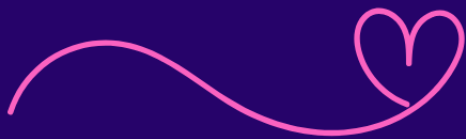


CAMP PRAYER UPDATE
